The Plea of Humility

Philippians 2:1-2

- 3 purposes of the church
1. To worship God.
 2. To build up the saints.
 3. To spread the good news of Jesus.
 - These things will require unity.
 - The word “IF” is better translated, “Since.”
 - “Then make my joy complete” by these 3 things:
1. Being of one mind.
 2. Having the same love.
 3. Being one in spirit and purpose.
 - *John 13:35*
 - *John 17:20-21*

The Practice of Humility

Philippians 2:3-4

- Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit.
- In humility, consider others more important than yourself.

The Pattern of Humility

Philippians 2:5-8

- He didn't cling to or demand His rights.
- He made Himself nothing.
- He humbled Himself and died an obedient death on the cross for our sins.

The Power of Humility

Philippians 2:9-11

- “Therefore or “Because of this”, God exalted Him to the highest place.”
- Jesus' humility was a BOLD humility.
- Because of Jesus' humble obedience:
 - He was crowned with glory and honor!
 - He was exalted to the highest place!
 - He was given the name above all other names!
